SAFE TOURISM – THE STATE POLICE HANDBOOK

Are you in Bologna for tourism or to see sporting events or shows?

For your safety, follow the advice of the State Police:

In case of danger, health emergencies or if you are a victim of or witness to crime, call the single emergency number "112" immediately and follow the instructions of the Authorities.



In case of theft or loss of goods and documents, go to the nearest Police Station to report it. The Police Headquarters Reports Office is in Piazza Galileo Galilei 7 and is open every day, including weekends, from 8 am to midnight.



Has your passport been lost or stolen and you don't have any other documents that allow you to travel by air?



If you are an Italian citizen, after making your report, go to the Police Headquarters Passport Office in Via Sant'Isaia 1 to have your passport re-issued. The Office is open Monday to Friday from 8.30 am to 1 pm and 3 pm to 6 pm.

If you are a foreign citizen, report the loss to the police then contact your country's Consulate.

- Also, remember:

- make a copy of important documents (passport, ID card) or keep a photo of them on your mobile phone.
- beware of pickpockets in crowded places and on public transport: always close the zips of pockets, bags and backpacks; do not keep your wallet or mobile phone in the back pocket of your trousers or in bags that open easily; carry rucksacks in front of your body and not on your back.

- be extra careful when you are out and about and wearing valuables.
- when at the train station or airport, do not leave your luggage unattended and, in case of emergency or urgent need, go to the Railway or Airport Police office on the premises.
- if using a car, do not leave goods or valuables inside when it is parked on the street.
